Count and non-count nouns

• COUNT NOUNS are nouns that can be made plural.

Most nouns are made plural by adding an -s (or -es, -ies).	Idea <u>s</u> ; role <u>s</u> ; proposal <u>s</u> ; assumption <u>s</u> ; belief <u>s</u> ; wish <u>es</u> ; speech <u>es</u> ; polic <u>ies</u> ; theor <u>ies</u>
Some nouns have irregular plural forms.	person → people woman → women man → men child → children

• NON-COUNT NOUNS are nouns that cannot be made plural.

Abstract ideas	freedom, peace, equality, anger, happiness, knowledge
CATEGORY	jewelry, furniture, machinery, clothing
MATERIALS AND LIQUIDS	coal, oil, water, steel, cotton, wood, plastic, rayon
ACTIVITIES	reading, studying, driving, voting, protesting
ACADEMIC DISCIPLINES	Mathematics, Sociology, Economics, Chemistry
OTHER NON-COUNT NOUNS COMMONLY MISTAKEN FOR COUNT NOUNS	information, help, evidence, advice, homework, research, development

• Some nouns are COUNT or NON-COUNT depending on how they are used.

COUNT	NON-COUNT
Abstract idea Culture can define a person's behavior	Specific example East Asian cultures have some similarities.
CATEGORY Drinking wine in moderation can have health benefits.	I TEMS FROM THAT CATEGORY France is a country known for its fine wines.
MATERIAL Pollution from coal is dangerous.	PIECES OF THAT MATERIAL The coals in the fireplace burned brightly.
