## Using nouns, adjectives, and adverbs correctly

- Use a noun, not an adjective, when you are naming something or someone.
  - o Example: The **racism** that exists in our society must be dealt with.
- Use an adjective, not an adverb, when describing a noun.
  - o Example: Many people of color experience racial prejudice.
- Use an adverb when describing another adjective or verb.
  - o Example: The **extremely** discriminatory practices within the police department must be reported if they are to change.
  - o Example: He acted **unfairly** when he refused to give her the promotion.
