#### **Review: Using nouns, adjectives, and adverbs correctly**

- Before you hand in a paper, check to see that all words are used in the correct word form. Remember that:
  - A noun (e.g., *education*, *economist*) names something or someone.
  - An adjective (e.g., *educational*, *economic* / *economical*) describes a noun.
  - An adverb (e.g., *educationally*, *economically*) can describe an action or an adjective.
